## IADR Kulzer Travel Award 2020 – young researchers can now apply

In recognition of the research young scientists conduct in the field of dentistry and their significant contribution to further development in the sector, Kulzer awards young researchers with the IADR Travel Award. Young scientists can apply for the Award 2020 now.

With the IADR Kulzer Travel Award, Kulzer wants to encourage young scientists to undertake research in innovative testing methods of dental materials, and new ideas and approaches to improve and develop dental materials. In 2019, more than 60 scientists from various countries applied for the IADR Kulzer Travel Award. The award covering the travel expenses will allow the winners to attend the 98<sup>th</sup> IADR General Session & Exhibition from 18 to 21 March 2020 in Washington, D.C. USA. The scientists will present their research results at the congress.

The award is granted to one researcher from each of the following regions, respectively: North America, Latin America, Europe, Africa/Middle East and Asia/Pacific.

Who can apply for the award? Young researchers (up to five years of post-graduation in the sector of dental, material science, specialty training, or pre-PhD) are eligible to apply for a travel award. Persons having already obtained a PhD are not eligible to apply again.
